

San Benito County CattleWomen 2024 Scholarship Requirements for Eligibility

- 1. The applicant must be a high school senior.
- 2. The applicant must be accepted by an accredited university, college, or trade school under a program that will help result in a career that supports the agriculture industry.
- 3. The applicant shall have a grade point average of at least 3.0 for grades 10, 11, and the first half of grade 12.
- 4. Application package must include:
 - a. SBCCW Scholarship Application
 - b. Copy of applicant's most recent transcript
 - c. A personal essay about your future career goals and how you intend to support the agriculture industry after graduation (500 words or less)
 - d. A list of extra-curricular activities, including community involvement
 - e. A list of work experience (this may include work at home or in the family business)
 - f. Two letters of recommendation
- 5. Verification of enrollment in an accredited university, college, or trade school must be submitted to claim scholarship.
